Trinity School at Meadow View is looking for a full-time Latin teacher at the secondary school level. All Trinity School students take Latin from grades seven through ten. Students begin with a comprehensive study of English grammar and an introduction to Latin in grades seven and eight, laying a foundation not only for these languages but also for all future language learning. In grades nine and ten, they continue the study of the Latin language, culminating in a reading of Virgil's *Aeneid* in the original language.

Qualified candidates include those with degrees in Classics or concentrations/minors in Latin or Classics. Other degrees would be considered if the candidate has a deep Latin background.

Qualification: Bachelors Degree in Subject (License not required)

Trinity School at Meadow View is one of three members of the nationally acclaimed Trinity Schools with sister schools in South Bend, Indiana and Eagan, Minnesota.
